Registration Instructions:

1. When registering, please provide all required information accurately and clearly on the registration form.. Please also pay the full tour fee at the same time.
2. When registering, you must have a valid travel document (passport) with at least 6 months or more of validity.
3. When registering, the agent travel agency cannot promote prices lower or higher than those listed in the price list (including tour fees and single room surcharges). Otherwise, complaints arising from this will not be the responsibility of our company!
4. When registering, please read the following information carefully on what is included and what is not included in the fees:
Included in the fees:
 - (1) Hotel: Guaranteed a locally rated 7 nights in local hotels (due to regional characteristics, not guaranteed to be 3-star throughout the trip)& hotel breakfast, hotel with private bathroom facilities. Double occupancy is the standard.
 - (2) Transportation: A luxury air-conditioned tour bus will be used for land transportation according to the itinerary. (Vehicle type will be adjusted based on the number of participants. For groups of seven or fewer, a driver guide and an air-conditioned minibus will be used.)
 - (3) Chinese tour manager (English speaking).

2. The transportation and hotels used by our company, such as planes, ships, trains, or buses, have different regulations to ensure passenger safety and prevent luggage loss, and each agency is responsible for their own rules. In case of luggage loss, accidental injury, or property damage, our company is not responsible and bears no liability, and the resolution will be based on the regulations of each agency involved.
3. In case of unforeseeable circumstances such as adverse weather conditions, strikes, typhoons, lost documents, unexpected hotel occupancy, flight cancellations or delays, political instability, epidemic or any other force majeure event that requires changes or cancellations of any travel program, accommodation or transportation, the company shall have the full authority to handle the situation accordingly. 5. In any situations and any locations, if theft occurs and results in the loss of money and personal belongings, our company, drivers, tour leaders, and guides will not be held responsibilities. It is the responsibility of each participant to safeguard their own personal belongings and identification documents.
6. If a participant is late and unable to catch the scheduled flight or bus, our company will not hold responsibilities and will not provide any refunds.
7. Due to different bus models, we may not be able to accommodate participants using wheelchairs. Therefore, it is regret to inform that we cannot accept wheelchair users to join our tour. (Note: For "private group tours", please inform us before receiving a quote.)
8. Our company reserves the right to publicly display participant's portraits taken during the tour. We will capture activities and moments during the trip for promotional purposes.

Tour rules and regulation notices:

1. Due to the limited luggage storage space on the coach, each passenger is allowed to bring one carry-on bag and one piece of checked luggage (total dimensions L + W + H must not exceed 158 cm, and weight must not exceed 23 kg). If you bring more luggage than the permitted amount (and if there is sufficient space in the coach luggage compartment), an additional €5 per extra piece of luggage per day will be charged as a handling fee for the driver. We apologize for any inconvenience and thank you for your understanding.

2. European tours are different from other countries in the world. Most tourist attractions cannot be reached directly by tour buses and tourists will be required to walk to the attractions. If a passenger has limited mobility, they may have to wait on the bus at some attractions and cannot visit some attractions together with the group. Loss of attractions cannot be used as a reason to request compensation or refunds. Please pay attention and think about it thoroughly before joining the tour. Once you have registered and confirmed your participation, it also means that you accept our company's terms and conditions.
3. The driver and tour leader serve the participants wholeheartedly, providing explanations of attractions, taking care of all aspects of the tour, and working hard. Please show your appreciation by giving them a tip before the end of the trip. According to European customs, each participant should give a basic tip of € 10 per day to the driver and tour leader.
4. Please present your tour ticket for boarding at the designated assembly point on time. The latecomers will not be waited, and the tour fee will not be refunded if he/she could not catch the bus. Our company is not responsible for any consequences. In case of emergencies, please call the emergency phone number provided.
5. Participants are responsible for bringing and carrying valid travel documents (passport) and visas with a validity period of at least six months from the departure date. In any case or for any reason, if the participant is refused to enter any countries by the immigration authorities (customs), our company is not responsible, and any losses incurred are the responsibility of the participant. The tour fee will not be refunded.

9. In any case or for personal reasons, if a tour member requests to leave on their own, return individually or leave the tour midway, our company will assist in making arrangements. However, our company will not be responsible for any indirect or direct cost losses incurred due to delays in transportation or other circumstances that result in missing the pre-arranged itinerary or accommodation.
10. Day 2: Reykjavik → Golden Circle → Kerið Crater Lake → South Iceland (220KM)

We'll head out for a lovely drive along the Golden Circle. Golden Circle.

[Pingvellir National Park] is the only location on the Icelandic mainland to hold UNESCO World Heritage status, and it is also the site of Iceland's ancient parliament. [The Geysir geyser] erupts every 1 to 2 minutes, gradually subsiding in between, creating a magnificent display. [Gullfoss (Golden Falls)] features two levels of cascading water. When the sun is out, the water droplets from the falls reflect a rainbow, giving the waterfall a golden brilliance—hence the name "Golden Falls." We will also visit to [Kerið crater lake], known for its vibrant green water and the striking colors of the crater on the surrounding hillside. Overnight in a town in South Iceland. *Should weather conditions permit, the aurora may be visible near the hotel that night. The Northern Lights in Iceland are a natural phenomenon caused by charged particles from the Sun colliding with the Earth's atmosphere high above. The success of a Northern Lights tour is highly dependent on weather conditions. Therefore, we cannot guarantee that you will definitely see the Aurora.

Day 3: South Iceland → Seljalandsfoss → Skogafoss → DC-3 Plane Wreck → Reynisfjara Black Beach → Vik → South Iceland (200KM)

After breakfast, we will visit the two major waterfalls in the south, [Seljalandsfoss] and [Skogafoss], where you can appreciate the magnificent beauty of the region. We then head to the [DC-3 wreckage]. Although the plane wreckage resulted from an aviation accident, the absence of casualties has led to the creation of one of the most distinctive non-natural landscapes in Iceland. Our next stop is the renowned [Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach], where the basalt columns on the beach provide a great photo opportunity. We will make a quick stop in [Vik], the southernmost town in Iceland. At the summit of the mountain in this town, you will find a small red-roofed church. Finally, admire the [Eldhraun] lava field from the bus, which was formed by a volcanic eruption. **Note: The itinerary order may be adjusted according to the hotel location and the situation on the day. The specific itinerary is subject to the tour guide's arrangements.**

Day 4: South Iceland → Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon → South Iceland (500KM)

After breakfast, we'll head to Vatnajökull, the largest glacier in Iceland. Icebergs break off from the glacier's edge and crash into [Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon]. Nearby, you can stroll along [Diamond Beach], a stunning black sand beach famous for its large iceberg fragments. During the winter season (Nov to Mar), we'll visit the [Crystal Ice Cave]. Led by an expert glacier guide, you'll be able to safely explore and admire this extraordinary natural wonder. During the summer season (May - Oct), we will take an [Amphibian Boat Tour] of the glacier lagoon.

Reference hotel: South Iceland Breakfast: hotel's restaurant Lunch & Dinner: not included. Freedom of choice

***Note:** Crystal blue ice cave are a rare natural phenomenon formed purely naturally and can only be seen in winter when the temperature drops below zero and the river water under the ice freezes. Each year, caves with very different styles form at different locations. Depending on prevailing conditions and safety, we will have an optional visit to a natural ice cave during our itinerary. *Crystal blue ice cave Exploration Group requires secondary confirmation of location.

Day 5: South Iceland→ East Fjords→ Egilsstaðir (550KM)

Today, we journey through the stunning [Eastfjords], traveling along narrow roads that wind between towering mountains and the ocean, witnessing the picturesque fjords. Our next stop is Djúpvogur, a charming fishing village. Explore the [Petra Stone Museum] (optional), see the famous outdoor sculpture [Eggin í Gleðivík], a series of large stone eggs symbolizing local bird species. Then, visit [Seyðisfjörður], one of the filming locations for the movie The Secret Life of Walter Mitty. Overnight in Egilsstaðir or nearby.

Reference hotel: Egilsstaðir or nearby Breakfast: hotel's restaurant Lunch & Dinner: not included. Freedom of choice

Day 6: Egilsstaðir→Dettifoss→Lake Myvatn→Goðafoss→Akureyri(300 KM)

After breakfast, we will visit Dettifoss, known as the most turbulent and voluminous waterfall in Europe (this attraction will be canceled in winter due to road closures). We' ll continue our journey around Lake Mývatn, a place shaped by volcanic forces and teeming with birdlife. The lake is dotted with over 50 small islands, all created by volcanic activity. Then, we will head to Goðafoss, the 'Waterfall of the Gods.' Spanning in a horseshoe shape, this stunning waterfall is steeped in history, tied to Iceland' s shift to Christianity when idols were thrown into its powerful waters. Overnight in Akureyri or nearby.

Reference hotel: Akureyri or nearby Breakfast: hotel's restaurant Lunch & Dinner: not included. Freedom of choice

Day 7: Akureyri→ Whale Watching→Reykholt(350 KM)

After breakfast, we'll experience [Whale Watching Tour] (optional). We' ll take a classic whale-watching boat as we venture out to spot these majestic sea giants in their natural habitat. We will then proceed to the stunning [Hraunfossar Waterfall], also known as the Lava Falls, which are a remarkable sight and flow into the Heveta River. A 10-minute walk along the riverbank will lead us to [Barnafoss]. Overnight in Reykholt or nearby.

Day 8: Snæfellsnes Peninsula→Kirkjufell→Arnarstapi→Reykjavik(300 KM)

After breakfast, you' ll head to all the wonders that the Hidden Gem of the West, the Snæfellsnes Peninsula, has to offer. We will make our way to [Kirkjufell], "The Church Mountain" , and Kirkjufellfoss waterfall. This iconic narrow mountain has become the landmark of Snæfellsnes in recent years, especially after being featured as the "Arrowhead Mountain" in Game of Thrones. Next, we will visit [Lóndrangar], a pair of rock pinnacles in Iceland, which are remnants of a larger crater that has mostly eroded away. Looming over the entire southern coastline, the 75-meter high basalt pinnacles of Lóndrangar set the tone for what' s to come. Then, we will visit the fishing village of [Arnarstapi]. Few places are as charming as this one, and here we will take a walk along the scenic coastline. You can enjoy lunch while taking in the beautiful scenery. Just east of Arnarstapi, we will stop to admire [Búðakirkja], a 19th-century church. Return to Reykjavik, and tour ends.
